

COVID-19 Liability Waiver and Affirmation of Conduct Restrictions

By registering with the FPA of Connecticut to attend the FPA Connecticut State Conference on Wednesday, April 27, 2022, at The Aqua Turf Club in Plantsville, CT, I agree to abide by all health and safety guidelines and recommendations then in effect as promulgated by the CDC, federal, state, and local government agencies and officials, FPA of Connecticut, and the event venue. Such guidelines and recommendations may include, but are not limited to, submitting to restrictions during the event that may consist of temperature checks, wearing a mask at all times in indoor public areas, and engaging in appropriate physical distancing and may change from those in effect as of the date of this registration.

I further agree that I will not attend this conference in person unless I have provided documentation showing either proof of full vaccination as defined by the CDC against COVID-19 or a negative COVID test 72 hours prior to arrival onsite (instructions on how to submit the required documentation will be provided closer to the event date) and that without such proof of vaccination or a negative test, I may be denied admittance to the conference.

Additionally, I understand that travel to and participation in events may increase the risk of exposure to communicable diseases. I hereby release, waive and forever discharge any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature against the FPA of Connecticut and its affiliated partners and sponsors, including in each case, without limitation, their directors, officers, employees, volunteers, independent contractors and agents (the "released parties"), either in law or in equity, to the fullest extent permissible by law, including but not limited to damages or losses caused by the negligence, fault or conduct of any kind on the part of the released parties, including but not limited to death, bodily injury, illness, economic loss or out of pocket expenses, or loss or damage to property, which I, my heirs, assignees, next of kin and/or legally appointed or designated representatives, may have or which may hereinafter accrue on my behalf, which arise or may hereafter arise from my attendance at this conference.
